PHILANTHROPIC ASSISTANCE TO BUILDING FUND

A grant of \$10,000 has been received by Euroa Health from the McEwen Foundation to furnish two private rooms at GraniteHill Aged Care Facility, currently under construction.

The McEwen Foundation funds are managed by the Foundation for Rural and Regional Renewal and Equity Trustees. The cheque was presented at a ceremony on June 22 attended by Euroa Health CEO, Mr. Wayne Sullivan.

“In addition to large lounge rooms and communal areas, GraniteHill Aged Care Facility will include a number of small spaces for the use of residents and visiting friends and families” said Mr Sullivan. “This grant allows us to furnish a private sitting room and dining room in a way that is both clinically suitable and visually attractive,” he said.

Lady Mary McEwen, wife of Sir John McEwen, Member for Murray and 18th Prime Minister of Australia, bequeathed funds for the benefit of the Goulburn Valley. Eight projects from around the Goulburn Valley shared in funding of \$67,500.
