A new Iris flower was bred to mark the occasion, named after the magnificent mare, and this flower has for many years graced the Spring garden at Seven Creeks Estate. Dusty Pink with orange spots and a purple centre, the Iris tubers have multiplied and will be available for sale at the Country Fair when gates open at 10am.

"It really is a showcase of Euroa at its best, designed for our whole community to celebrate Spring" said Kerry. "We hope that people will come from far and wide to see, hear, smell, touch, and taste the best Euroa has to offer."
