

Announcement to the Euroa Health community

Euroa Health recently announced a restructure which resulted in five administration and support positions being lost.

There has been no loss of positions in direct care areas.

This action was taken to ensure the financial sustainability of the organisation given increasing costs and the concern that the organisation has been in deficit in the past few years.

These past deficits have been funded using our healthy reserves, however these accumulated funds will be directed towards our new aged care facility opening in 2017.

It will be no longer possible to sustain operational deficits so it was felt that an immediate restructure was needed to address over expenditure and balance budget projections. We acted now to ensure that other jobs would not be lost in the future, because of increasing operational costs.

The aged care project, which has been generously supported by local individuals and businesses, has not been affected by this restructure. All donations are kept separate from the running costs of the hospital. All donations are used for the purpose for which they have been kindly given.
