Our Urgent Centre is open when your General Practitioner is closed and you need Medical & Nursing Care that cannot wait until your GP Practice reopens.

When to present to our Urgent Care

- Pain
- Centre
- Earache
- Common cold, flu, cough or fever
- Cuts, scrapes or lacerations
- Allergies and rash (with or without a fever)
- Mild asthma or croup
- Sprains and strains
- Sore throat
- Urinary Tract Infection
- Nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea
- Support with chronic health care as needed

COST

\$60 payable to Euroa Health on the day (eftpos available) and
50% off for Euroa Health Inc. members \$30

AND

- **\$50** billed separately at the discretion of the Euroa Medical on-call Doctor.





WHO PROVIDES MEDICAL CARE? Care is provided by Nurses and on call Doctors.


Advice can not be given by telephone, please attend our Urgent Care Centre for assistance

When to call 000

- Any shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Any symptoms of a heart attack including chest pain in the left arm or jaw, sudden weakness or dizziness
- Signs of a stroke such as numbness, slurred speech, severe headache, weakness on one side of the face or loss of consciousness
- Life or limb threatening injury

Euroa Health's Urgent Care Centre DOES NOT HAVE XRAY facilities at this time, so should you have a suspected fracture please present to a local Emergency Department.

> We will assist you in any medical situation which can include stabilising you or your family members medical condition and assisting with arranging Emergency Transfer to a larger Emergency Department via Ambulance.
