

Urgent Care Centre

Our Urgent Care Centre is located on Kennedy Street Euroa and available to the entire community when Euroa Medical Family Practice in Binney Street Euroa is closed, so that the on-call General Practitioners are available for us (6pm to 6am every night and all day Sunday)

When to attend our Urgent Care Centre

- Pain
- Earache
- Common cold, flu, cough or fever
- Cuts, scrapes or lacerations
- Allergies and rash (with or without a fever)
- Mild asthma or croup
- Sprains and strains
- Sore throat
- Urinary Tract Infection
- Nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea
- Support with chronic health care as needed

When to call 000

- Any shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Any symptoms of a heart attack including chest pain in the left arm or jaw, sudden weakness or dizziness
- Signs of a stroke such as numbness, slurred speech, severe headache, weakness on one side of the face or loss of consciousness
- Life or limb threatening injury

Euroa Health's Urgent Care Centre DOES NOT HAVE ACCESS TO XRAY facilities during its opening hours, so should you have a suspected fracture please present to another local Emergency Department.

We are pleased to have Ultrasound on Wednesdays (additional days are made available to meet Community demand) and XRAY is available each Tuesday and Thursday morning.



Gym

Our modern and spacious gym is located in the heart of Euroa Health Acute Hospital building and can be conveniently accessed via Weir Street.

While our gym is at times used for therapy sessions for our patients and residents, the gym remains open as a community owned gym. Our gym is fully equipped with cardio machines including cross trainers, rowing machines, treadmills, steppers, bikes, cable machines, free weights, exercise balls, medicine balls, balance equipment and much more.

Euroa Health offers a single, concession or couple gym membership options, which require a compulsory primary membership of Euroa Health Inc. New gym members are required to fund and undertake a one-on-one gym assessment with our Exercise Physiologist to learn how to use the equipment safely and effectively to ensure best program outcomes.

Using our gym can be helpful for anyone to achieve their health and fitness goals whether it be weight loss, muscle development or rehabilitation and a gym program can be tailored to suit you if required.
